Posters:

Please ensure that posters meet all criteria as set out in the TSTSbooklet :

- On the topic “Survival in or Land”
- Clear scientific message
- Max size A2
- 2D only: Suitable for wall display
- If using cut-out lettering, please ensure this is well glued on!

Please pack posters FLAT rather than rolled

Creative Writing:

- May be prose or verse
- Max size ONE side of A4 sheet
- On the topic “Survival in our Land”
- Clear scientific message conveyed through creative use of words
- Packaging in a “plastic pocket” gives protection to the work

Every entry MUST be accompanied by an entry form signed by student’s teacher, an entry fee of \$5 per entry, or a request from the school that all fees be billed at the end of the year.
